*Swimming has been a highlight over the last few weeks.*

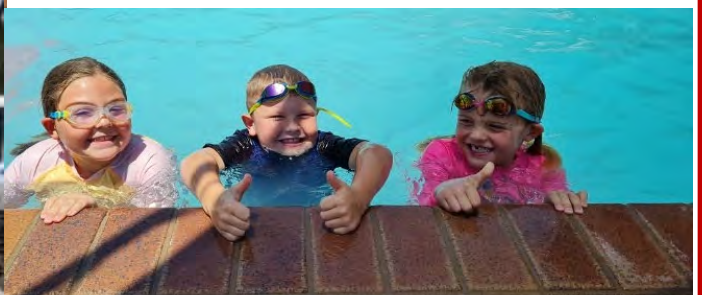


## Year 6 Luncheon

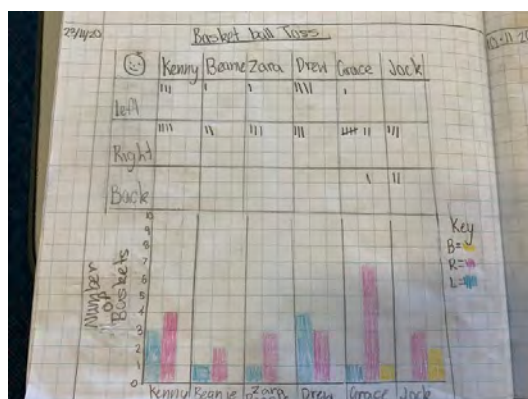
