Check-In Assessment: Year 3 - 6

Recently all the children in Year 3 – Year 6 undertook a reading and numeracy assessment here at school called the Check-In Assessment. These were devised by the NSW Department of Education last year when NAPLAN had to be cancelled

This way, all children in the class will benefit from the funding, as it reduces the student to teacher ratio during these group work sessions.

In the meantime, a number of our staff from Wee Waa have not been able to get into Burren Junction. Miss Coles, Mr Hardy and I will therefore continue to run the classes at Burren Junction Public School until things return to normal.

2022 Excursions—Updates

The NSW Department of Education's Covid advice is that overnight excursion are on hold until further notice, and we are waiting on the advice for 2022. However, we still need to plan for our overnight excursions in order to secure bookings. Mrs Deacon is planning the 3 day excursion to Lake Keepit for the Year 3 children and I have been working on the Sydney Excursion (Stage 3) as well as the Canberra

and the Snow excursion (Y4 – Y6). Once dates can be confirmed then we will organise meetings to discuss the excursions and the need for volunteers.

Sydney Excursion: Year 5 & 6, T2, 2022

All the current Year 4 and Year 5 parents have agreed to the school rescheduling the 2021 Sydney excursion to 2022. I have been able to secure three apartments in Pyrmont for our 12 students, two teachers and 2-3 parent volunteers, and this will be at no cost to the school. Mrs Slack-Smith, as relieving principal, will head this excursion. I will be in contact with the parents who volunteered to assist on this excursion to organise the numbers, as we can only take a maximum of 3 parents. Thank you to all our parents for completing the survey that went out and for all of your generous offers to assist.
