# From the Principal

This newsletter has had to have a bit of a rewrite as we are now in a learning-from-home situation and so some of the things are no longer relevant.

I would like to start by thanking you all for your vigilant testing and communication with us. It is important that you notify us as soon as possible of any new cases so we have a good understanding of the situation to inform us of our next steps. The Covid response team then make a recommendation which is reliant on us being able to provide accurate information. Children may not be symptomatic or may test negative with symptoms for a few days and then finally get a positive.

As for what this all means for excursions, I will communicate as soon as I have the most up to date information. There is a meeting this afternoon with updates on overnight excursions. Obviously, no child who is positive can attend and any child testing positive on excursion will also need to be collected. We are still committed to the excursion going ahead and hope that this break until Monday should help us get on top of any outbreaks.

Class teachers are the first port of call if you have any questions around learning from home and have emailed you all today what the next two days will involve.

### **Reading Across the School.**

As you are aware we are working as a collective to see how many books we can read this term. Mrs Stump had many students visit the library on Tuesday to borrow some more books. While learning from home we encourage children to do a lot of reading.

Staff were going to undertake professional learning today to look at the fluency data for our children and where we could target for improvement. As this was face to face with Rowena, we have now rescheduled it.

### **The Year 1 Phonics Screening Check**

There are several checkpoints as children progress through their school years with NAPLAN being the main one for many years. All children in NSW starting school are assessed using the Kindergarten Best Start Assessment. As of last year, the Year 1 Phonics Screening Test was introduced. This is also now an across the board assessment which all year one children are to complete. The information below is provided by the Department of Education to supply information about the test.

Phonics is the relationship between letters and sounds and is vital in learning to read. Some children struggle with learning to read so it is important that these children are identified quickly so teachers can plan for any specific support they may need.

The Year 1 Phonics Screening Check is a short, quick assessment that tells teachers how your child is progressing in phonics. Your child will sit with the teacher and will be asked to read 40 words aloud. These words include 20 real words and 20 nonsense words. The test normally takes a few minutes. If your child is struggling the teacher will stop the check. The check is carefully designed not to be stressful for your child.

The assessment includes pseudo or nonsense words to see if the student is able to use their knowledge of blending to read a word rather than their memory of having seen that word before.
